



Weekly Newsletter - Monday 7th September 2020

I hope that your children have enjoyed their time back in school so far and that they are making the most of seeing their friends, their teachers and that they're enjoying learning together again. Thank you all for your patience when dropping off and collecting the children. I know it may be frustrating and take us longer to dismiss the children at the end of the school day, but we do need parents to maintain social distancing in the yard and keep to the areas set out. Your support is very much appreciated. I'm pleased to announce that we are now in a position to open up our breakfast clubs on each site from next week, starting on Monday 14th of September. There will be some changes to the way that the breakfast clubs run:

Foundation Phase (Infant) Breakfast Club

- Opens at 8.20 am with children entering through the Year 1 entrance (the main office school door)

- Last entry to breakfast club will be 8:45 am. Children who arrive after this time will unfortunately not be able to enter.

When your children come into breakfast club, they will have toast, milk and fruit available to them to eat at their class table in the hall.

Children from different classes will not be able to mix during breakfast club to maintain the class bubble. Your child will be collected by a member of school staff at their allocated start time and go into class.

If your child has a high temperature, a new persistent cough or a loss/change in taste or smell, please do not send them to breakfast club.

Key Stage Two (Junior) Breakfast Club

- Opens at 8.20 am with children entering through the Year 5 entrance opposite Lidl. Parents should enter the yard through the bike shed entrance on Mile End Row, drop the children off, and then leave through the pedestrian exit on School Road.

- Last entry to breakfast club will be 8:45 am. Children who arrive after this time will unfortunately not be able to enter.

When your children come into breakfast club, they will have toast, milk and fruit available to them to eat at their class table in the hall.

Children from different classes will not be able to mix during breakfast club to maintain the class bubble. Your child will be collected by a member of school staff at their allocated start time and go into class.

If your child has a high temperature, a new persistent cough or a loss/change in taste or smell, please do not send them to breakfast club.
