On Wednesday this week, our Year 6 children will be going up to visit the new Cefn Saeson Comprehensive School building which looks fantastic! The children will be leaving school at 9.15 am and will return in time for lunch. They should wear school uniform and make sure that they're on time as we can't delay the busses for pupils who are late, sorry. Parents of Y6 children should have had a letter giving more details last week.

This fortnight, the Welsh language pattern we're using in school is 'Beth wyt ti'n wneud?' which means 'What are you doing?'. You can answer by saying 'Dw i'n ...' which means 'I'm ...'

This year we hope to be able to run our Summer Holiday Enrichment Programme (SHEP) in the summer holidays. The scheme runs from 8.30 to 12.30 Monday to Thursday for the first three weeks of the summer holidays and is open to pupils from the current Year 2 up to and including the current Year 6. The children will have breakfast, sports, art and crafts activities as well as lunch with us in school. There is no cost to parents for the scheme - it's free! I will be sending letters out to parents in Years 2 to 6 with more information and a sign-up slip that will need to be returned to school to secure a place. We are limited to 40 pupils attending each day so it's best to return the form as soon as possible.

Parents on the Key Stage Two site will have noticed improvements being made to the area next to the demountable building. We are grateful to Flying Start for funding the improvements and I'm sure that the children from both settings will love working in them.

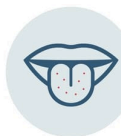
