It was lovely to welcome the Year 2 children down to the Key Stage Two site last week. I think they were all a little nervous about coming down, but I hope that they're a bit more excited about the change now.

The Year 6 children enjoyed taking part in their cycling course last week. It was great to see them learning how to keep safe in the local area on their bikes and I'd like to thank the Road Safety Team for organising the training for our children. Children are welcome to ride their bikes to school on the Key Stage Two site and they should bring a chain to lock it up and ideally wear a helmet.

Finally, I'm pleased to announce that the school has appointed two new teaching assistants to support the children and teachers. Miss Prescott and Miss Chiplin are working on the Foundation Phase site.
