



School Newsletter – Monday 5th of July 2021

On Monday 12th and Tuesday 13th of July, your children will be moving up to their new classrooms and meeting their new teachers for two days to help them to settle ready for September. We'll be sharing who the class teacher will be for your child and site entry/exit details in their school report which will go out this Friday 9th of July. To keep things simple for parents, the children will have the same start and finish times on those two days as they currently have each day in their current class. Breakfast club will be available on both sites for both days from 8.20 am.

From September, it looks very much like we will be stopping the 'staggered start' times that we have had during the COVID pandemic. This means that, when the children return to school in September, their start and finish times will be as follows:

Year Group	Start Time	End Time
Nursery AM	8.45 am	11.15 am
Nursery PM	12.40 pm	3.10 pm
Reception to Y2	8.50 am (doors open 8.45am)	3.15 pm
Year 3 to Y6	8.50 am	3.20 pm

The school will be looking at updated information from the Welsh Government and Local Authority regarding any other COVID related changes from September and we will adjust our risk assessments and practice as needed. Be assured our priority is to keep our children, parents and staff as safe as possible.

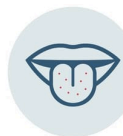
