I hope that your children have enjoyed their first day back in school with their new class teacher. It's been lovely to see the children being able to play with a wider group of children and enjoying their learning in their new classroom. We're still going to be handwashing, making sure classrooms and toilets are ventilated well and that we keep our distance from each other, where possible.

I have received updated guidance from the Welsh Government and they have confirmed that learners, staff and other adults should not come into a school/setting if they:

- have tested positive or have COVID-19 symptoms
- have been told by TTP to self-isolate or
- if they live with someone who has symptoms or has tested positive for COVID-19 – unless they are fully vaccinated or are under 18.

This means that our **pupils** do **NOT** have to self-isolate unless they themselves have symptoms or a positive test result.

There have been some changes to the staffing in the school. I'm pleased to be able to welcome Mrs Rhian Davies and Mrs Natalie Davies back to the school on a full-time basis and to be able to welcome Miss Richards to the position of Additional Learning Needs Co-Ordinator (ALNCo) for our Key Stage Two (junior site). Mrs Asquith will be Additional Learning Needs Co-Ordinator for pupils who are on the Foundation Phase site. I'm also pleased to be able to welcome Mrs. Jeremy permanently to the Senior Management Team of the school as she takes the lead of Foundation Phase Teaching and Learning. I'd like to wish Mrs. Cooke well on her two-term Welsh language sabbatical and know that the class is in good hands with Mrs. Cameron. Miss Cooze will be acting up on the leadership team while Mrs. Cooke is away from school. It's fantastic to have such talented and dedicated teachers working hard to give your children the best learning opportunities possible.

We currently have a vacancy for Parent Governor on our Governing Body and will provide further information this week on how to nominate someone to stand for election to the position.
