

Dyslexia - FAQs



"I think my child is not making enough progress with his/her reading and writing in school. What should I do?"





Make an appointment to discuss your concerns either with your child's class teacher, or with the Additional Learning Needs Co-ordinator (ALNCo). School should be able to tell you exactly how your child is progressing.

If you feel that your child's reading/spelling or work or homework is too difficult for him/her, you can speak to the class teacher about providing work that has been adjusted for your child's needs.

Try not to show your child that you are anxious about his/her progress as he/she will pick up on this.
