


Dyslexia - FAQs



“I’m not sure if my child has any support in place in school – how can I find out?”





If you are unsure what support has been put in place for your child, you should ask to speak to your child's class teacher or the school's Additional Learning Needs Co-ordinator (ALNCo). They should be able to supply you with this information, as well as answer any questions you may have about your child's progress.



Support for your child could take various forms, such as:

- **differentiated activities (teaching a child differently according to their needs, capabilities or preferred learning styles)**
- **dyslexia-friendly classroom strategies**
- **small group intervention/paired activities**
- **literacy or numeracy programmes**
- **use of IT**
- **concessions for exams and tests**
