




“How can I make sure that all of my child’s teachers are aware of my child’s learning needs?”





Ask your child's teacher or the Additional Learning Needs Co-ordinator (ALNCo) about writing a 'One Page Profile' for your child.

A One Page Profile will provide information about your child's strengths, areas of difficulty and how he/she learns best.

This can be especially important in secondary school, where your child will have several different teachers.

Here is an example of a 'One Page Profile'



Harri's One Page Profile

All about me - My name is Harri Tomos Williams. I am 6 years old and my birthday is on 9th December 2009. I live at home with my Mami, Dadi and our dog Gwen. We live in xxxxx and I go to xxxxx Primary School. I am in year 1.



What is important for me?

- I like talking about dinosaurs, animals, places I've been and things I've seen. It is important for me to have opportunities to share my thoughts and ideas this helps me understand and learn.
- I sometimes find it hard to concentrate and get a bit fidgety. It is important that I have the chance to move and change activity regularly.
- I like learning in the challenge areas in class because I can play and its quiet so I can concentrate.
- I learn best when topics I like are used to help me learn things and I like learning through problem solving tasks.
- I learn best when the activity is fun, practical and makes me use as many senses as possible.



Sometimes I need help with.....

Writing - I sometimes find it hard put my ideas into writing, the sentences are in my head but I can't always get them out. I need support to remind me of how to form my letters and to sound out big words.

Turn taking - I sometimes find it hard to wait my turn especially when I'm excited to share an idea. I need a prompt or a cue to remind me that my turn will come.
