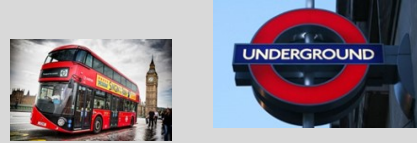
Research and write some facts about an important event that changed London forever in 1666.




Make a model of a famous London landmark. For example: Buckingham Palace, The Shard.




Make a poster about how people travel around London.





Before the Great Fire of London, there was another event that took place at the Houses of Parliament in 1605. Research and write some facts.




Draw and label a picture of Big Ben.




After the Great Fire of London a building was built to remember this event. What was it? Draw or write facts about this building.




Design your own fireman costume that would have been worn in 1666.




London is a very popular place to visit. Make a poster or leaflet explaining why people should visit this city.




There are lots of famous London football teams. Research and write 3 facts about one of the teams.




Write a short adventure story about visiting London in the present or in the past.




Make your own poster comparing the similarities and differences between Queen Elizabeth II and King Charles II.
