Dear Parents/Carers,

I would like to thank you for the outstanding way in which you have responded to the advice given in my previous correspondence. I can report that the significant majority of pupils have remained at home in line with Government Guidance to help to prevent the spread of the COVID-19 virus. Therefore, as of Tuesday 24th March, we will be providing the key worker child care service at the Non Campus for years 1 - 9 and at the Aidan Campus for nursery and reception.

The overall key message is: Learners should stay at home to stop the spread of the virus and protect the NHS.

I am delighted that pupil response to our remote learning has been remarkably encouraging with staff reporting extremely high levels of engagement. I would like to pay tribute to my amazing staff for their response in providing online resources and to the support staff for enabling this initiative to happen. Whilst learning continues, it is also important to focus on the wellbeing of our pupils. Online learning enables staff to keep in touch with the pupils in their classes and form/class teachers are making regular checks on their pupils.
