Return to School in September 2020

Welsh Government announced last week that the autumn term in Wales will start on Tuesday, 1 September 2020. The Minister has said she will allow time, up to a fortnight, for any planning and reorganisation. There will be a period of flexibility in recognition that schools may want to focus on priority year groups. It is expected that all schools will be open to all pupils by Monday, September 14 at the very latest.



This week schools have received the operational and learning guidance from Welsh Government in order to support schools during this transition. We will ensure that we consider it carefully, alongside advice from Pembrokeshire County Council. When operational plans are in place for how we aim to begin the term in September we will be in touch with you to share them.
