
Schools, community groups and councils along the

We are aiming to provide habitats for wildlife (hopefully lots of different birds will visit and nest), increase biodiversity, reduce levels of carbon in the atmosphere and of course positively impact climate change by planting trees provided by the Coastal Communities Adapting Together project.

Tom talked to the children as he was planting. He explained how to look after the trees and help them to grow. He even left us a super, big red watering can, to water our trees. We will keep you updated!
