Update – March 2021

KS2 Return

This morning it has been confirmed that we can go ahead with plans to welcome back all pupils in KS2 (Years 3-6) on Monday 15th March. It is our intention that all pupils (including KS2 LRB pupils) will return fully on this date. If there are any concerns regarding pupil wellbeing or if a more careful transition is needed, please contact the school to discuss further. LRB staff will discuss the best options for individual pupils to ease back into full-time provision. On their return, Year 3 pupils can now be collected from the Bellway gate (rather than the classroom) at the slightly earlier, temporary time of 3:35pm.

Breakfast Club

Breakfast Club will restart on Monday 15th March. As the operation of breakfast club requires additional control measures to keep contact groups separate in the hall, we continue to politely request that you only use Breakfast Club if absolutely necessary (eg for unavoidable early work commitments or where breakfast may be otherwise unavailable.) We will contact families currently registered for Breakfast Club to discuss requirements next week. If you require a registration form, please contact the office.

Lateral Flow Testing

The Welsh Government has offered school staff the option to take lateral flow tests twice a week with the intention of this complementing the primary control measures already in place in schools. The use of these tests is voluntary and they are not intended to be used as a condition to enable schools to reopen.

Please be aware that the introduction of testing individuals who do not show any classic symptoms could lead to an increase in the numbers of cases detected which could affect classes. Staff have been reminded that the existing strict measures of social distancing, the wearing of face coverings and scrupulous hand hygiene remain as the primary protective measures for reducing transmission in school and in the community.

We look forward to returning to full operations from the 15th and are excited to see our older pupils return. As always, please keep following the guidelines outside of school so that community transmission is kept low to enable this to happen safely.
