


Trengrouse Newsletter, Wednesday 6th July 2016

Hi there. Here is some home-learning to help the children in the next week of lessons. We are undertaking our final Rising Stars assessments next week so extra practise in key areas will help!

English/Topic

Create a map (you could use skills from our Ordnance Survey map sessions) and use it to create a story that involves a character going on a quest (journey).



Maths

Practise the following skills, ready for the final assessments next week...

- Times table facts and related division facts (i.e.) $3 \times 6 = 18$, $30 \times 6 = 180$.
 $18 \div 3 = 6$, $180 \div 6 = 30$.
- Number bonds (i.e.) $25 + \underline{\quad} = 100$
 $150 + \underline{\quad} = 1000$
- Addition and subtraction strategies.
- Multiplication and division strategies (i.e.) grid, column, chunking or BUS STOP.

Extra Challenge

'an' spelling pattern

Abundant, admittance, importance, dominant, resistant, acquaintance, assistance, expectation, reluctance,.

Choose at least 5 spellings from either list and practise spelling them. Then, create up-levelled sentences for each of the chosen five, using a variety of punctuation and sentence types.
