Hi there, here is the home-learning for the final week of half term and over the holiday.

Maths:

We'll be looking at telling the time on analogue and digital clocks after half term. The children need to know how to convert between 12 and 24 hour time too.

Convert the 12 hour times to 24 hour below.

1. 10:15pm
2. 8:15am
3. 8:30pm
4. 12:00pm
5. 1:25am

Now, convert the 24 hour times to 12 hour.

6. 08:00
7. 22:45
8. 19:35
9. 03:45
10. 21:40

The children could also keep a diary, recording the times they do something.

English/topic:

Our next topic is Dragons - Fact or Fiction. As a mini project, we'd like the children to invent their own dragon through a drawing with a brief summary of its key characteristics.

It would be great if they could also create a model of their dragon to display in class during the topic!

Spellings - 'or' words

Challenge: - no rule - just interesting words to use!
