Maths:

Factor pairs - in our learning on area, children have been using factor pairs to find and calculate area of rectangles.

Please find all factor pairs for the totals listed below...

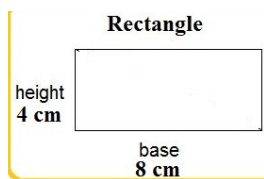
Example

$$\begin{aligned} 30 &= 1 \times 30 \\ &2 \times 15 \\ &3 \times 10 \dots \end{aligned}$$

1. 25 2. 32
3. 13 4. 18

Extension (not compulsory!)

Use the factor pairs to draw three rectangles with the area of three of the totals. You'll need a ruler to measure them!



English:
