Equivalent fractions this week - can you use images (remember the shape must be the same size) and/or multiplication/division facts to show equivalent fractions? Look the examples below for help...



$1/2$ is the same as $2/4$ (as shown in the image above)

Now, create an equivalent fraction for the fractions listed below and show how...

$2/3 = \underline{\quad}$ $3/5 = \underline{\quad}$ $6/9 = \underline{\quad}$

$4/9 = \underline{\quad}$ $7/11 = \underline{\quad}$ $8/48 = \underline{\quad}$

Can you create five other equivalents of your own?
