

Well Done Y6 - Amazing SATs Results

This week children in Year 6 finally got to hear how they have achieved in their end of Key Stage 2 SATs tests. As you may know, in May each child is tested in reading, writing, maths and SPAG (spelling, punctuation and grammar). Now, we knew the children had worked very hard this year and that they were well prepared for the tests. We obviously also knew that, like all of the children at Perranporth, Y6 are simply fantastic and wonderful learners. However, what we didn't know was just how well they had done! We are immensely proud to say that this year Davy Class have excelled themselves and achieved simply incredible results!

- ★ In Reading 90% of children met the standard (national average 71%)
- ★ In Writing 90% of children met the standard (national average 76%)
- ★ In Maths 87% of children met the standard (national average 75%)
- ★ In SPAG 97% of children met the standard (national average 77%)
- ★ This gives a combined outcome for reading writing and maths of 80% (national average 61%)



Just like the children who achieved them, these are simply outstanding results. They have beaten all national averages by a large margin and attained incredible standards. A massive well done to the Year 6 children, their parents for all of their wonderful support and the staff for all of their hard work too. Well done Perranporth!
