Interest needs to be logged with either the office or Mrs Whatley before the end of November. Please remember that if your child is in receipt of Pupil Premium funding, the school will happily use some of this funding to provide music lessons for free! Just let us know if your child is interested.

What is Pupil Premium Funding and is my Child entitled to it?



We'd like to remind all of our parents that if you are what the government terms 'on a low income' your child may qualify for Pupil Premium financial support. Children don't have to take meals as 'free school meals' if they don't want to but, if they are on our Pupil Premium Register, then they might qualify for all sorts of other financial benefits throughout the year.

This is because when a child is on our Pupil Premium Register, our school receives extra funding for that child which has to be spent only on the education of the children on our Pupil Premium Register. The purpose of this extra money is to ensure that children from low income families are not at a financial disadvantage during their education as a result of home financial circumstances. Some of the financial benefits of being a Pupil Premium pupil at Perranporth could include:

<u>refree school uniform</u> refree access to after school clubs and sports reday and residential visit subsidies refree educational resources (eg., books, phonics flashcards) redaitional support in school, either 1-1 or as part of small groups refree music lessons - to name but a few!

Pupil Premium funding applies to any pupil who has been eligible for free school meals during any period in the last 6 years. It is vitally important that parents who think their child might be eligible apply for this funding. If your child is not already on the Pupil Premium Register and you think that you might be eligible or you'd like further information please pop into the School Office or look on our website for the application form; our admin staff will be only too happy to talk to you or help you fill out the form.

Everybody wins when children eligible for Pupil Premium are registered for this additional funding. This helps parents financially and the school receives extra government money to spend on our Pupil Premium children. Most of all, your children win as they don't miss out because of financial circumstances.

So if you think you may be eligible, please do apply. You have nothing to lose and potentially a lot to gain!
