We are receiving a number of absence requests from parents wishing to take children out of school for family holidays. At Perranporth School, we recognise that there are occasions when it is appropriate to authorise an absence in exceptional circumstances. However we do not authorise requests for the purpose of holiday. If parents decide to take their children out of school without authorisation, this would be committing an offence under the Education Act 1996. Persistent absences not authorised by the school may result in issuing a Penalty Notice or prosecution in the Magistrates Court and involvement from an Educational Welfare Officer.
