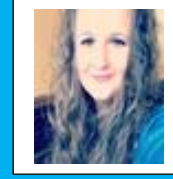

Article 28: the right to an education

This term our theme is 'Beach Combers'. We will continue to develop our handwriting, spelling, reading and writing through our RWI sessions. We will also be developing our understanding of vocabulary and scientific language and learning about 'Changes to our bodies' through our jigsaw scheme with Jigsaw Jo. We will also be preparing for changes in our classes and offering opportunities to transition up to Year 3 ready for September. We will also be practicing our sports activities ready for our sports day.
