Mae gwyliau'r Haf wedi dod i ben ac y mae pawb yma yn Ysgol Gymraeg Pontardawe yn eiddgar i groesawu'r holl ddisgyblion yn ôl i'r ysgol.

Trefniadau ail agor yn llawn

Fel pob ysgol arall, bydd yr ysgol ar gau ddydd Mawrth 1^{af} a dydd Mercher 2^{ail} o Fedi er mwyn i'r staff gwblhau'r newidiadau angenrheidiol i'r amgylchedd dysgu, mireinio'n systemau mewnol a diweddarau hyfforddiant. O ddydd Iau 3^{ydd}, bydd y disgyblion yn dychwelyd yn raddol (gweler yr amserlen sydd ar ddiwedd y llythyr). Bydd yr ysgol wedi agor yn llawn erbyn dydd Iau'r 10^{fed} o Fedi.

Helpwch ni i sicrhau fod y disgyblion yn dychwelyd mor llyfn â phosib trwy ddarllen y wybodaeth isod yn ofalus a'i drafod gyda phwy bynnag fydd yn hebrwng y disgyblion i'r ysgol a'u casglu o'r ysgol.

- Gofynnwn i rieni i wirio nad yw eu plant yn dangos unrhyw symptomau cyn mynychu - tymheredd uchel, pyliau peswch cyson neu newydd a / neu golled neu newid i arogl neu flas. **Os ydynt yn arddangos y symptomau yma, ni ddylent fod yn yr ysgol.**
- **Hylendid** - Trwy gydol y dydd, bydd pwyslais ar hylendid a golchi dwylo'n rheolaidd.
- Mae disgwyl i ysgolion leihau'r cyswllt rhwng dosbarthiadau cymaint â phosib. Felly'n anffodus, bydd disgyblion yn aros o fewn eu dosbarthiadau amser gwersi, amser chwarae a chinio.
- **Cwdyn a chas pensiliau** - Bydd angen i ddisgyblion ddod â sach gefn bach sy'n cynnwys eu cas bensil eu hunain (pensiliau, beiros, rwber ac ati), llyfr gwaith, blwch cinio a photel ddŵr. Bydd y rhain yn aros gyda nhw wrth eu desg trwy'r dydd.
- **Gwisg Ysgol** - Dylai plant wisgo gwisg ysgol i'r ysgol gan ei bod yn werthfawr i gyfrannu at ethos ysgol.
- **Cinio** - Bydd angen i ddisgyblion ddod â'u pecyn cinio eu hunain, byrbryd iach a photel ddŵr (wedi'u labelu'n glir â'u henw). Gall yr ysgol ddarparu cinio (cwdyn bwyd), ond bydd angen talu am hwn drwy ParentPay. Ymddiheuriadau, ni fyddwn yn gallu derbyn arian parod am rai misoedd eto. Tra bo' rhieni disgyblion prydau bwyd am ddim yn derbyn taliadau gan yr awdurdod, bydd angen iddynt dalu trwy ParentPay am ginio ysgol. Bydd y taliadau hyn yn dod i ben ar ddydd Gwener 11^{eg} o Fedi. Bydd y Cwdyn Bwyd yn yn cynnwys brechdan ham, tiwna, caws, jam, twrci (dewis disgybl), pecyn o greision, darn o ffrwyth, diod a darn o gacen.
- **Clwb Brecwast** - Cynghorwyd ysgolion Castell-nedd Port Talbot i beidio cynnig clwb brecwast yn wreiddiol. Gwyddom gymaint mae rhieni'n ei werthfawrogi, felly byddwn yn gweithio gyda'r Awdurdod Lleol i ddatblygu dull o ail agor yn ddiogel cyn gyflymed ag y gallwn.
- **Gollwng a Chasglu** - Fel nad yw'r dosbarthiadau'n cymysgu, darperir amser cyrraedd a chasglu penodol i'r adrannau (gweler yr amserlen sy'n dilyn y llythyr). Mae'n hanfodol bwysig i chi gyrraedd y maes parcio rhwng yr amseroedd hynny – nid cyn nac ar ôl hynny. I hwyluso gollwng a chasglu i rieni, gall brodyr a chwiorydd gyrraedd ar yr un amser a'r plentyn hynaf. Bydd gofal wedi'i drefnu yn eu dosbarthiadau eu hunain ar eu cyfer. Cyfrifoldeb y plentyn hynaf fydd tywys eu brawd / chwaer ifancaf i'w dosbarth. Yn yr un modd bydd teuluoedd yn gadael ar amser casglu'r plentyn hynaf.
- **Pellter Cymdeithasol** - Er mwyn cynnal pellter cymdeithasol gofynnwn i rieni ddefnyddio'r man gollwng ac osgoi parcio ble'n bosib. Os ydych yn parcio gofynnwn i chi leihau'r amser cymaint â phosib. Gofynnwn i chi osgoi sgwrsio yn y maes parcio. Bydd cynnal llif y traffic yn bwysig iawn. Byddwn yn monitro'r maes parcio ac gofyn i unrhyw un sy'n parcio tu allan i'r amseroedd casglu penodol parcio rywle arall.
- **Bysus** - Fel deallwn, bydd trafndiaeth (bysus) yn rhedeg fel arfer. Mae trefniadau yn eu lle i dderbyn disgyblion sy'n cyrraedd yr ysgol ar fws.

- Yn anffodus, ni fydd y staff ar gael i siarad â rhieni ar ddechrau a diwedd y dydd gan fod yn rhaid i ni leihau'r cyswllt rhwng oedolion ar y safle. Os oes angen i chi siarad â'r athro, e-bostiwch yr ysgol ac fe gysyllta nhw â chi.
- **Derbynfa** - Bydd y dderbynfa **ar gau** ac ni fydd ymwelwyr yn cael mynediad i'r ardal yma heb apwyntiad – am y tro gofynnwn i chi gyfathrebu trwy ffôn neu e-bost (dull gorau) yn unig. Pwysleisiwn – ni fydd drws y dderbynfa yn cael ei agor. Os yw'r disgyblion yn hwyr, arhoswch yn y maes parcio, ffoniwch yr ysgol ac fe drefnwn aelod i staff gasglu'r disgybl o'r maes parcio.
- Wrth symud o amgylch yr ysgol, bydd angen i staff a disgyblion gadw at system un ffordd weithredol yn ogystal â chadw at y 'rheol 2m' ble'n bosib. Bydd marciau gweledol ar y llawr i'w hatgoffa.
- **Masgiau** - Darperir cyfarpar diogelu personol i staff. Bydd ei angen arnynt mewn rhai sefyllfaoedd. Dewis personol fydd hi i staff gweddill yr amser. Yn ôl y cyfarwyddyd yr ydym wedi dderbyn, nid oes gofyn i ddisgyblion cynradd wisgo masg.

Cynghorwyd ysgolion i gyhoeddi eu hasesiadau risg ar gyfer dychwelyd i'r ysgol sydd i'w gweld ar y linc isod. Gydag unrhyw asesiad risg, caiff ei adolygu'n rheolaidd, gan sicrhau ei fod yn parhau'n addas ac yn ac yn ymateb i'r canllawiau diweddaraf.

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Dear parents and carers

Summer holidays have come to an end and everyone here at Ysgol Gymraeg Pontardawe are looking forward to welcoming all pupils back to school.

Full re-opening arrangements

Like all other schools, the school will be closed on Tuesday 1st and Wednesday 2nd of September for staff to complete the necessary changes to the learning environment, refine our systems and update training. From Thursday 3rd, pupils will be invited back in a phased return (see timetable that follows this letter). The school will be fully open from Thursday 10th September.

Please help us make the pupils return as smooth as possible by carefully reading the information below and discussing the content with whoever escorts your children to and collects them from school.

- We ask parents to check that their children do not show any symptoms before attending - high temperature, persistent or new cough attacks and / or loss or change of smell or taste. If pupils exhibit these symptoms, **they should not be in school.**
- **Hygiene** - Throughout the day there will be an emphasis on hygiene and regular hand washing.
- Schools are expected to reduce contact between groups. Therefore, unfortunately pupils will stay in their classes for lessons, break time and lunch times.
- **Bag and Pencil Case** - Pupils will need to bring a small rucksack containing their own pencil case (pencils, pens, rubber etc), workbook, lunch box and water bottle. These will remain with them at their desk all day.
- **School Uniform** - Children should wear school uniform to school as it plays a valuable role in contributing to the ethos of a school.
- **Lunch** - Pupils will need to bring their own packed lunch, healthy snack and water bottle (clearly labelled with their name). The school can provide lunch (a grab bag), but this will need to be paid for through ParentPay. Apologies, we will not be able to receive cash for some months. While parents of free school meals pupils receive payments from the authority, they will need to pay through ParentPay for school meals. These payments will come to an end on Friday September 11th. Grab Bags will contain ham, tuna, cheese, jam, or turkey sandwiches (pupil choice), a packet of crisps, piece of fruit, drink of squash and a piece of cake.
- **Breakfast Club** - Neath Port Talbot schools were advised not to offer breakfast club during September. We know how much parents value this facility, so we will be working with the Local Authority to develop a safe re-opening plan hopefully by the end of the month.
- **Drop off and collection** - So that classes do not mix, departments are provided with a specific arrival and collection times (see the timetable that follows this letter). It is vitally important that parents arrive between these times and not to arrive before or after. To aid drop off and collection for our parent, siblings will be able to arrive at the same allocated time as the eldest pupil time and they will be supervised in their own class. It will be the older pupil's responsibility to escort their brother / sister to

their class. At the end of the day families will leave at the collection time of the eldest pupil (who will collect their siblings prior to leaving the building).

- **Adult social distancing** - In order to maintain social distancing we ask parents to use the drop off point in the car park. Staff will escort pupils from the car park into the building. If you need to park we ask you to minimise the time as much as possible. Maintaining traffic flow will be very important. We will be asking anyone who parks outside the allocated drop off times to leave the car park.
- **Buses** – As we understand, transport (buses) will be running as normal. Arrangements are in place for to supervise pupils who arrive by bus.
- Unfortunately, staff will not be able to stay and talk to parents at the beginning and end of the day as we need to reduce contact between adults on site. If you need to talk to the teacher, email the school and they will contact you.
- **School reception** - School reception will be **closed** and visitors will not gain access to this area without an appointment – for the time being could we ask you to communicate only by phone or email (preferred method). If pupils are late, please remain in the car park and telephone school who will arrange for a member of staff to collect the pupils.
- When moving around the school, staff and pupils will need to adhere to a one way system as well as adhering to the '2m rule' where possible. There will be visual markings on the floor to remind them.
- **Masks** - Staff are provided with personal protective equipment. It is required in some situations. Thereafter, it will be a personal choice for staff. According to the instruction we have received, primary pupils are not required to wear masks.
