



Staffing: We say goodbye to Ms. Kelly Crichton at the end of this term. We thank her for her hard work at lunch times and wish her the very best for the future.

Enterprise Sale: Thank you for supporting this event. We raised £388 for school fund. The PTFA raised an additional £113. The School Council will help determine how this money is spent.

Parking Permits: New parking permits will be available from the school office in September. Current permits (yellow) will no longer be valid. Parking permits allow you to park free of charge in the Shopper's car park (off the bypass) from 8.40-9.20 and 3.10-3.50 on school days. We hope that parents/carers will walk the short distance to school and reduce congestion in Slough Road and in the school's car park. This will also help reduce pollution in and around the school.

Junior Swimming: (Years 3 to 6): Swimming will start in the week commencing 9th September. Further details will be sent out at the start of next term.

Grant Money: We have been awarded £1000 by the *Youth Participation and Support* charity to develop reading in the school. We are currently auditing the books in school and will be purchasing new books to support the reading scheme. Mrs. Stinton is coordinating a complete review of the reading scheme, including the colour banding system. We hope to have a system that helps teachers and parents monitor progress against age related standards. Developments will be ongoing in the new school year.
