**Parking Permits:** available from the school office. These will allow you to park in the 'shoppers' car park' at the beginning and end of the school day for free. New permits are required each year.

**Birthdays:** Unfortunately, we are currently unable to share birthday cakes and biscuits in classes.

**Staggered start/end of day:** Many thanks to all parents as this system seems to be working well. Please use the one-way system and EXIT the grounds through the single gate (Caenbrook Meadow end) if you have walked.

**Colds:** Please follow the Government's guidance regarding colds/sickness when determining if your child should come into school. Please contact the school office on all days of illness or self-isolation.

**Hand sanitizer:** Children may bring their own although we have supplies for them. If children use their own, its use will be supervised and the alcohol content should be at least 70%.

**Asthma:** Please complete the online form (link below) if your child has asthma and requires an inhaler. It allows us to administer an inhaler in an emergency situation. Form also available from the school office.
