Social Distancing: Thank you to all adults and children for following social distancing guidelines. Only one adult should drop off/collect children.

Parents' Evenings: There will be no face to face meetings this term (in line with guidance). If you have a concern or wish to discuss your child's progress, please telephone the school to arrange a remote meeting with the class teacher, which will be held over the telephone or via MS Teams.

Collecting children at the end of the day: Please inform the office or teacher if there is a change to how your child is getting home. This includes if someone different is collecting him/her.

Positive Test result: At the weekend, please email the office if **your child** has received a **positive** Covid test result. This will be checked on Sundays.

Only email to alert us to a **positive test result** of a **child in this school**. To inform us of self-isolation and suspected cases, please use the normal communication channels i.e. ring the school in the morning.
