

WALT - complete litre and millilitre Word Problems

Remember 1L = 1000 ml

- 1) A jar has 300ml of jam. I use 150ml on my toast. How much is left in the jar?

- 2) Mary was naughty and filled her mum's shoe up with cooking oil. Each shoe holds 150ml. How much oil did Mary put in her mum's shoes?

- 3) I have 1 litre of water in a jug. On the way to my table, I spill some. I have 400ml left. How much have I lost?

- 4) I have 1 litre of sprite. I give 100ml to William, 100ml to Paul and 100ml to Mickey. How much do I have left?

- 5) Katie does not like milk so she gives me her 200ml glassful of milk. Jade also gives me her 200ml glass because she is full. How much milk do I have?
- 6) I have a big bucket. I need to put 1 litre of water in it, but I only have a 250ml container. How many containers of water do I need to put in to fill my bucket?
- 7) Johnny and Anthony fill up some water-balloons with water. Inside each water-balloon there is 300ml of water. They each have two balloons. How much water do they need?
- 8) Tom and Max are lost in the desert. They each have a 1 litre bottle of water. Max drinks half of his bottle. How much does Max have left?
- 9) Tilly and Rilee buy water guns from Tesco. The capacity of Rilee's is 1 litre 200ml and Tilly's is 2 litres. What is the capacity of the two water guns?
