My Mum is cool as (an ice cream, a snowman , an icicle, spiderman)

My Mum is as cuddly as a (bear, fluffy jumper)

My Mum is as caring as..... (nurse, your Nana)

My Mum is as special as..... (the queen, the twinkling stars)

My Mum is as funny as (clown, joke)

Mu Mum is as yummy as (chocolate, cake, a hot cross bun)

My Mum is as wise as..... (an owl , yoda)

My Mum is as magical as..... (a unicorn, a wizard)

And I love her very much / And I love her to the moon and back.
