## Coronavirus Update

How exciting, we will be together again next week. Only 3 more sleeps until our new normal. The school building is ready and the staff are eager to meet the pupils for their catch up and check in. Thank you for teaching you children about the need for social distancing, washing hands and using and disposing of tissues. However, under no circumstances should learners or staff attend schools/setting if they:

- feel unwell, have any of the three identified COVID-19 symptoms (a new continuous cough, a high temperature or loss of taste or smell) or they have tested positive to COVID-19 in the past 14 days or
- live in a household with someone who has symptoms of COVID-19 or has tested positive to COVID-19 in the past 14 day.

Please contact the school immediately if you have suffered for either of the above.

Here are a few reminders of our new normal.

- 1) Pupils have been provided with their weekly class bubbles. Sadly the pupils are unable to move bubbles.
- 2) The local authority cannot offer transport to and from school.
- 3) During this period our school uniform expectations have been relaxed. However, pupils must wear appropriate school clothes.
- 4) Entry, exit times and locations have been staggered. Please see the table below.
- 5) The school will take your child's temperature on arrival.
- 6) There is no need to bring a bag of pencil case into school. Lockers and coat hooks cannot be used. Coats will be hung on the back of each individual chair.
- 7) Pupils will be provided with an individual set of classroom equipment. These will remain in school.
- 8) All pupils will be provided with a free mid morning snack.
- 9) All pupils are encouraged to bring a clearly labelled transparent water bottle.
- 10) All pupils will purchase a school grab and go packed lunch at £2.30 per pupil per day. Payment can be made through Parent Pay or will the correct money in a clearly labelled envelope. Please label the envelope with your child's name, class and bubble day. All children entitled to free school meals will be expected to pay for their meals as registered families will continue to receive a weekly BACS payment. Thank you.
- 11) To minimize movement around the building we have had to reorganise the toilet facilities. Please see welcome back slides.
- 12) Our term will now end on Friday 17th July.
