### **COVID-19 HEALTH ADVICE**

We are aware that pupils, staff and parents are concerned about the virus. We are constantly being updated by the LA and Public Health Wales. We will share this information with you as we get it. This will ensure that you get the correct information and alleviate some of the scaremongering.

#### **The current advice as of today-**

If staff or pupils have symptoms of coronavirus infection (COVID-19), however mild, they should stay at home and not leave the house for 7 days from when symptoms have started.

#### **5. What to do if a case of COVID-19 (pupil, student or staff) is suspected in your childcare or education setting**

If anyone has been in contact with a suspected case in a childcare or educational setting, no restrictions or special control measures are required while laboratory test results for COVID-19 are awaited. There is no need to close the setting or send other learners or staff home. As a precautionary measure, the NHS are currently testing a very large number of people who have travelled back from affected countries, the vast majority of whom test negative. Therefore, until the outcome of test results is known there is no action that staff members need to take apart from cleaning specific areas (section 13) and disposing of waste (section 14) Once the results arrive, those who test negative for COVID-19 will be advised individually about return to education.
