**Maths:** Tables 8 x 9 x

**Year 4/5: Time:**

Work out how long different tv programmes last for- hours and minutes.

Diary of your day- how long do you spend doing work, watching tv, playing, walking and doing anything else.

**Money:**

Work out the change from different amounts eg from £20.00, £10.00, £5.00

Make shopping lists and add up the amounts.

**English:** For writing, see Topic below.

**Reading:** Please continue to read daily, using either school or home books.

**Spelling:** Weeks 26, 27 & 28 spelling lists.

**Topic:** Our topic this term is Mountains, Volcanoes & Glaciers.

Prepare a PowerPoint or a report using sub-headings on volcanoes, eg  
How they are formed.

Where in the world they are found.

Differences between active and dormant volcanoes.

Carry out a case history of 3 famous volcanoes- stating things like how many people were injured etc.

Make a model of a volcano- using things you have at home.

Sketch and label a volcano.
