Mrs Lewis - Year 3/4

In light of the school closures as a result of the Coronavirus Pandemic, we have put together a list of suggested activities, linked to the work your children have been doing in class so that they can continue with their learning while they are at home.

Maths: Tables x 2,3,4,5,6,7,8,10

Year 3/4: Telling the time - o'clock, half past, quarter past and quarter both analogue and digital. Practise writing a timetable of your day and keeping a diary. Revise the number of days in a week, months in a year, days in a year, weeks in a year, hours in a day, minutes in an hour and seconds in a minute.

Use a calendar if you have one and revise how many days there are in each month. Remember to use the poem (Thirty Days Hath September) or the knuckle trick to help you work it out.

Measure - use rulers or tape measures to measure everyday objects (remembering to start your measuring at zero). Use objects both indoors and outdoors. You could keep a record of plant growth (remember to use the correct units cm's).

Follow recipes weighing out objects can you double and half your recipes?

English: Writing – To write about a mountain setting

Things to include and think about:

What can you see? What can you smell?

What does it feel like? Temperature etc Where is this setting located?

You might like to include a simile e.g. The cloud was fluffy like cotton candy.

What might you find here?

Reading: 'The man who bought a mountain' – You can access this as an eBook on Twinkl.

Spelling: Weeks 26, 27 and 28

Topic: Our topic this term is Mountains, Volcanoes & Glaciers.

Draw and label the parts of a mountain.

Research a mountain in Wales and create a fact file.

List all the mountains in Wales recording their heights. Can you identify the tallest mountain in Wales?

Can you sketch what is outside your window? Maybe you can see a mountain.

All pupils have logins for Hwb and these can be found in their KIT books.

This is an excellent platform for research for children and they can use Word, PowerPoint and Excel to help them present their work.

TT Rockstars is a great way to practise your times tables and we can see lots of you have been working hard using it regularly – well done!
