



Dear Parent/ Carer,

As there is at least one key worker in your family, you have been able to access support for face to face learning at school in order to carry on your work, which is critical to ensuring support towards the COVID crisis.

Please note that the government guidelines state:

*'Many parents working in these sectors may be able to ensure their child is kept at home. Every child who can be safely cared for at home should be'.*

If you or anyone in your household/ care bubble works shifts and are not on a rota to work on a particular day or you have annual leave, children should be kept at home that day. Trying to keep community mixing to a minimum is a priority in keeping transmission rates down and there is evidence that real progress is being made due to the lockdown. Please can you be mindful of this when sending your children into school.

Could we also ask that you email your shift patterns and days that you require emergency child care in school to Mrs Sharp by Friday each week, so that we can plan a staffing schedule, as we are restricting the number of staff on site at any one time for their safety.

Thank you for your cooperation; pupil and staff safety is always our priority.
