In light of the school closures as a result of the Coronavirus Pandemic, we have put together a list of tasks for Wednesday – Friday in the first instance. It is linked to the work your children have been doing in class so that they can continue with their learning while they are at home.

Maths: Continue to have fun with numbers, recite/count and recognise numbers to 20, 50 and then 100. Think about odd and even numbers within 20

Revisit simple addition and subtraction stories using number bonds to 10 (write the sums you can make on paper). $6+4=$, $7+3=$, $5+_=10$

Mentally think of numbers bigger than 20 and then 50 (this can be a fun game as you walk or travel in the car). Find numbers on a hundred square. Write them down on paper.

English: Continue to practice Phase 1, 2 and 3 of the Jolly Phonic Scheme singing the rhymes and practice the actions.

Listen to the stories on line. There are lots of interactive games online on the Jolly Phonics website.

Reading: Read Oxford Tree Reading Books (**available online**) look out for initial letter sounds and high frequency words. Begin to identify capital letters and full stops at the beginning and end of a sentence. Use class reading books to look for words or sentences to write down.

Draw and write. Draw a favourite Christmas toy or gift. Write a sentence saying why it is your favourite OR write a simple thank you sentence for the person who bought it for you. Year 1 remember to write simple sentences using independent spelling “**have a go spelling**”

Topic: Our topic this term is **Transport Explorers**. We will begin by looking at our local environment. Think about what we see on the way to school or on a local walk. Look out for street furniture such as lamp posts, post boxes, bus stops and shops etc. We will also be looking at different modes of transport to travel further afield, such as into other towns and cities around us. Draw pictures and label what you have seen.
