You could keep your work in an exercise book if you want. Perhaps one for English/Topic and one for maths. If parents would like to pick these up from school, please phone and arrange a pick up. Alternatively, for work that is not in Word, you could take a photo and either upload it or email it to me. Please set your work out as you would in class, write a title or Learning Objective and please underline them.

Maths: Multiplication tables – the focus this term is on x6, x7, x9
Maths Facts – continue with learning these important maths facts.
Multiplication/Division Test 1 for Year 5 and Year 6
Mental Maths 1 for Year 5 and Year 6
Converting Measurement:
Year 6 there are two tasks and an information sheet.
Year 5 there are two tasks for Group1 and Group 2

English:

Reading: Please continue to read daily, using either school or home books.

I have also uploaded 'First News 758'. There are 3 reading activities for you to do: Animal News, Science News and Sport News. You may complete all 3 or choose 1. They are multiple choice questions. Please highlight the correct answers.

Spelling: Year 5 – Set 14 – Spelling Word Exercise

Year 6 – Set 15 – Spelling Word Exercise.

Topic / Science:

Following on from last term's Science work on Electricity, I have uploaded work on the History of Electricity:

Activity sheet on 'How Electricity has impacted on our lives'.
