

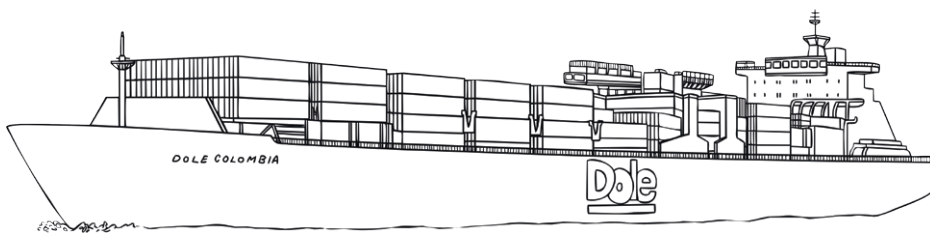
How Far Did My Food Travel?
