

Literacy:

We are learning about **Instructional texts**.

- Could you write a set of instructions for making a jam sandwich?
 - Could you invent a simple game and write a clear set of instructions so other children could play?
- (Remember to include what equipment is needed and clearly label each step.)

Maths:

We are revising strategies for:

- adding and subtracting numbers quickly in our heads
- multiplying and dividing numbers
- multiplying larger numbers using grid method
- Finding fractions and percentages of amounts

Science:

We are learning about **life-cycles** of plants and animals

- Can you find out about the different stages frogs and butterflies go through.
- Choose an animal of your own and describe its life cycle

Geography:

We are learning about **rivers and their features**.

- Can you find the longest river on each continent and its length in km
- What can you find out about the River Dee?
 - How long is it? -Where does it start (source) -Which sea does it flow into?
- Are there any examples of the following features along its course:
 - A Waterfall, Lake, Rapids, Meander, Estuary?
- What wildlife can be found at different points along its course?
- How is the Dee used by humans (work, leisure)?
