I have = I've

You have = you've

Drop the 'ha' in 'have', so use an apostrophe (') instead.

Can you shorten the 'I have' and 'You have'?

Example:

I have seen Mr Bean the movie.

I've seen Mr Bean the movie.

2. You have eaten the chocolate!
3. I have made a cake.
4. You have read all the books.
5. I have looked everywhere!
6. You have made a mess!
7. I have got to catch the bus.
8. You have got to brush your teeth.
9. I have run out of time.
