



Offsite Activities Consent

Offsite activities are important experiences that pupils should have as a normal part of their education. We want to ensure that we can offer a broad range of educational visits and trips to all of our pupils.

Please sign and date the form below if you are happy for your child:

- To take part in school trips and other activities that take place off school premises; and
- To be given first aid or urgent medical treatment during any school trip or activity.

Please note the following important information before signing this form:

The trips and activities covered by this consent include;

- all visits which take place during the school day, after school, during holidays or a weekend,
- residential visits,
- off-site sporting fixtures outside the school day,
- use of off-site facilities or venues for normal school activities,
- all off-site activities for all pupils including nursery.

With this agreement, written parental consent will not be requested from you each time for the majority of off-site activities offered by the school as such activities are part of the school's curriculum and usually take place during the normal school day, however we recognise that it is important that you know where your child will be at all times, and will ensure that you are informed when children are taken off site.

We will send you information about each trip or activity before it takes place and you can if you wish, tell the school that you do not want your child to take part in any particular school trip or activity. We will also ensure that risk assessments are put in place and you are aware of any extra safety measures required.

This consent will be recorded for the whole time your child is at our school but can be withdrawn or updated by you at any time.
