Signing up process for students:

- Go to gcsepod.com
- Click login on the top right
- Select "New Here? Get Started"
- Select Student
- Students must enter their details into the form (First name, last name, date of birth and school name)
- Students will then need to select a username and password. It's recommended that the pupil uses their email for their username but it is not a requirement
- Pupils will then be able to select their subjects. By default, all subjects are selected. It doesn't matter if the pupils select the wrong ones as this can be changed in their account settings at any time.
