Your child's data will be processed in accordance with the UK's Data Protection Act 2018 and the General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR). Data collection is taking place through a secure online survey platform and all data will be stored on password-protected devices. Data will only be viewed by the named research team.

Is participation voluntary?

Your child's participation is entirely voluntary – your child does not have to participate if they do not want to.
