From 20/04/2020 all pupils attending the Hub must bring work with them, which has been set by their teacher. If you have booked a place for your child and you think your child has completed all their tasks, or if you are not sure about what to send in with your child, please contact your child's class teacher (contact e-mails are on our website under 'home learning') to ask for advice. Please give your child's teacher plenty of time to respond.

Parents who are front-line workers and need to access the Presteigne School Hub should e-mail the following address to book pupil places:

As of w/c 20/04/2020 – no further late bookings will be accepted (and therefore no further turn up on site applications.)

Parents must apply weekly for a place in the Hub. On-line booking closes as of 5pm every Wednesday.

Parents will then receive two e mails:

1. Receipt of application
2. Confirmation of place. Within this e mail, there will be a link for parents to allow them to cancel a place by e-mail if they no longer require the session booked.
