Happy return to school!

It has been wonderful to see almost everyone in school this week and teachers and TAs all have the same news; the children are happy and excited to be back!

It's been a joy to hear the children's stories about their lockdown activities at home with you.

In the **Children's Centre** the children have come in amazingly well and are getting used to being ready to learn.

Reception children have had one day this week (which worked really well) and they've settled in brilliantly.

Y1/2 pupils have been 'all smiles'!

Y3 have loved finding out about the different branches of science and about famous scientists.

Y4 pupils have taken all the changes in their stride!

Y5/6 pupils have shared lovely lockdown memories and are getting excited about this term's topic, 'Myths, Magic and Mystery'.

Teachers have asked me to remind parents/carers of the following:

- **All pupils need to have wellies in school.** Wellies should have your child/ren's names written inside **BOTH** wellies and be brought to school in a named plastic carrier bag so that they can be easily stored in school. As children will be learning outdoors in all weathers all children need waterproof coats in every day.
- **Reception pupils** also need to have a complete change of clothes, brought to school in a named bag.
- Children should wear their **PE kits to school on their PE day**. If they need to wear a jumper, it should be a school jumper. Plain dark jogging bottoms/leggings are acceptable.

PE days are as follows:

- Hwyaid Bach (Reception) - Monday
- Eyr & Gwennol (Yrs 1/2) - Tuesday
- Jac-y-do (Yr 3) - Tuesday
- Cnoc-y-coed (Yr 4) - Tuesday
- Aderyn du & Barcud Coch (Yrs 5/6) - every OTHER Thursday
(Mrs Rimmer's class goes first, on Thursday 10th September & Mrs Watts on Thursday 17th September)
- Specialist Centre - Monday and Friday
- All pupils need to bring named, filled, water bottles into school.
- Packed lunches must be sent in containers that can be easily opened by your child/ren without the need for adult help. NB: Lots of the children are unable to open 'Frubes'.
- It is important to note that any food/packaging brought from home must be taken back home by individual learners. **This includes break time apple cores and banana skins etc. Please ensure your child has a way of storing these in their school bags to bring home.**
- **Please make sure you send UPDATED information to Sarah in the office about any medical conditions.**
