Safety of all Pupils, Parents and Staff

For the safety of all of our pupils, parents and staff can you please ensure that you continue to only arrive at the school about 5 minutes before your child's start and finish times.

This will reduce the number of parents and children at any one time and enable us as a school community to continue to follow Welsh Government social distancing guidelines. Traffic outside the Prioryville Site

Please can we all ensure that we show courtesy for the residents who live close to our school. Since returning to school there have been incidents where residents and other parents have informed the school about unsafe driving and illegal parking.

Please can all parents / carers ensure that they park in a sensible and legal space when dropping or picking up at the beginning and end of each school day. Please do NOT park anywhere where there are double yellow lines and certainly not in front of either of the school gates on Brooke Avenue or Prioryville. These need to be kept clear at all times for emergency vehicle access. As we have to on the Meads site we are still unable to permit any vehicular access onto Prioryville at present, apart from Blue Badge Holders, permit holders and staff. Some parents have asked us to consider opening the gates on the Prioryville site to vehicles, However, as we are still unable to allow access onto the playgrounds before and after school we feel that this would present an increased risk to the safety of pupils who are waiting to go into class, many of whom have walked to school on their own. Also we need to allow sufficient space for pupils and parents to wait socially distanced in this area.

Welsh Government Data Collection

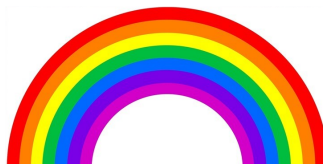
